7 **Where do I Go? Resolution**

9 WHEREAS: The Student Association Senate is the representative body for the students of the
10 University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma and the unified voice that affirms
11 students’ concerns; and,

13 WHEREAS: Troutt Hall is visited by prospective students, members of the community, and
14 other guests of the University who are not familiar with campus frequently; and,

16 WHEREAS: Troutt Hall currently does not have directional signage that gives directions to
17 accessible entrances to the building; and,

19 WHEREAS: The accessible entrances to Troutt Hall are behind the building and difficult to
20 locate without directional signage; and,

22 WHEREAS: Adding directional signs to the accessible entrances for Troutt Hall decreases
23 liability for the University and increases independence for people with
24 disabilities.

26 **NOW THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT ASSOCIATION**
27 **SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND ARTS OF OKLAHOMA THAT:**

29 SECTION 1: The Student Government Association shall urge the University of Science and Arts
30 of Oklahoma to add directional signage for accessible entrances to Troutt Hall.
